



WHAT IS LEARNING POVERTY?

Learning poverty is the inability to read and understand age-appropriate text. The Philippines has the highest level of learning poverty rates in Asia, at 91%, which means that 9 out of 10 children in our country below 10 years old have low proficiency in reading and comprehension.

A DVANCEMENT IN R EADING A ND L EARNING

ARAL is Gawad Kalinga's response to the pressing problem of learning poverty. GK uses this program to bring together local stakeholders such as public school administrators, teachers, volunteers, and parents to focus on poor readers in their community. Adopting the "Marungko" method of teaching, children are given intensive reading sessions outside of school for a minimum period of 3 months. After this period, they are given the standard DepED (Department of Education) assessment test to measure the improvement in their reading and comprehension levels.

ARAL PROGRAM

- Enlistment of learners done in collaboration with public schools
- After-school intensive reading sessions by volunteer teachers
- Groups of 30-50 children per school community
- 3-month learning sessions
- Learning improvement measured through DepEd assessment tool

Based on the pilot implementation sites in Mindanao, out of 100+ learners, almost all have have progressed from their current level of reading to the next. This is proof that if we work together, we can improve literacy rates and enhance learning skills of children in need. Reading is the foundation of learning, help us equip our children with skills that they need to have a brighter future!





VOLUNTEER TEACHERS

ARAL is one of GK's strategic programs to capacitate the youth and prepare them for a poverty-free future. It works in conjunction with other programs such as Kusina ng Kalinga, Maleta Library, SIPAG and SEED.
